



→ Organic growth in all regions.


Acquisitions

Geographic breakdown Q2

Nordic region

→ Sales growth was good in DK, FI and SE, while the NO market developed negatively during the quarter.

Western Europe

→ DE, IT and the NL showed positive sales development during the quarter, while sales in the UK and ES decreased.

Eastern Europe & CIS

→ CZ, PL and SI grew during the quarter, while sales in the markets of AZ and HU decreased.

North America

→ In local currency, sales increased in both the US and CA markets during the quarter.

Middle East, Asia, Australia and Africa


→ SA, AU and MY showed good growth during the quarter, while sales in MA decreased during the quarter.

Adjusted operating profit Q2

- → The gross margin amounted to 37.7 percent (37.3).
- → The operating profit for the second quarter amounted to SEK 390.2 million (346.9). The operating margin amounted to 11.9 percent (11.0).
- → Selling and administrative expenses for the quarter amounted to SEK 830.4 million (813.4), an increase of SEK 17.0 million or 2.1 percent. Acquired companies contribute SEK 8.0 million of the cost increase. Selling and administrative expenses in comparable units have increased by SEK 9.0 million.







Profit after tax Q2

- → Net financial items for the second quarter amounted to SEK -37,4 million (-24.7).
- → Currency effects on long term receivables, loans and bank balances amounted to a net of SEK -16.3 million (-7.0).
- → Interest expenses for the quarter amounted to SEK -18.8 million (-19.2).
- → The tax rate amounted to 24.8 percent (26.8)

- → Changes in working capital mainly due to increased trade receivables +180 (+61).
- → Net investments primarily in the Czech Republic, Sweden and Saudi Arabia.
- \rightarrow Leverage was 0.73 (0.71).




"Heat Pump Innovation of the Year" Award for Menerga CO₂mpass AHU"

Menerga was rewarded for its CO₂mpass airhandling unit with integrated heat pump at the ATMOsphere Europe Summit.

The CO₂mpass AHU uses R-744 (CO₂) as a refrigerant; minimal global warming potential, PFAS-free, non-toxic and non-flammable.

Designed for public pool dehumidification, the unit also heats the pool and provides domestic hot water.

Menerga CO₂mpass was unveiled at ISH 2025 earlier this year.





New Mercedes-Benz car factory in Spain

- → Mercedes-Benz's second largest car factory is located in Vitoria, Spain. This plant is now being further expanded with brand-new production lines for electric vehicles.
- → For the new paint shop, Systemair will supply high-performance Geniox air handling units.
- → The order, valued at 1.3 million Euros, demonstrates Systemair's ability to deliver energy-efficient solutions that meet the needs of a major global player in the automotive industry.
- → The first electric vehicles will roll out from the factory in 2026



Energy efficient chemical operations in the port of Antwerp

- → Systemair has signed a contract with Alfa-Technical Installation, working on INEO's Project ONE, aiming at becoming one of the most energy-efficient and raw materials efficient olefin complexes in Europe, with minimal environmental impact at its core.
- → Systemair's order includes large axial fans and modular air handling systems, equipped to meet EU directives for equipment in explosive environments (Zone 1).
- → High ventilation capacity is combined with safe operation in environments where explosive gases may occur, making it suitable for industries with strict safety requirements.
- → Systemair's project is valued at **700,000 Euros**.
